Ingredients

Linseed Meal, Ground Corn, Ground Oats, Soybean Oil, Dried Black Soldier Fly Larvae Meal, Feeding Oat Meal, Porcine Animal Fat Preserved with BHA and Citric Acid, Rice Flour, Dried Plain Beet Pulp, Chicken Meal, Ground Flaxseed, Cellulose, L-Lysine, Dried Apple Pomace, Monocalcium Phosphate, Dicalcium Phosphate, Calcium Carbonate, Salt, DL-Methionine, Taurine, Preserved with Mixed Tocopherols, Pyridoxine Hydrochloride, Choline Chloride, Cholecalciferol (Vitamin D3), Citric Acid (a Preservative), Folic Acid, Zinc Amino Acid Complex, Manganese Amino Acid Complex, Calcium Pantothenate, Copper Amino Acid Complex, Zinc Oxide, Vitamin A Acetate, Cobalt Acetate, Manganous Oxide, Menadione Sodium Bisulfite Complex (Vitamin K), Nicotinic Acid (Niacin), Thiamine Mononitrate, Ferrous Carbonate, Riboflavin-5-Phosphate, Vitamin B12 Supplement, d-Alpha Tocopheryl Acetate (Vitamin E), Copper Sulfate, Rosemary Extract, Zinc Sulfate, Calcium Iodate, Sodium Selenite, Cobalt Carbonate, Biotin.

Feeding Directions

- Feed 1 – 3% of body weight or as directed by your nutritionist.
- The amount of diet the animals require will vary according to the size, age, life stage, health status, and activity of the animal and the environmental temperature.
 - Adjust as necessary to maintain desired weight and body condition.
- Always provide plenty of fresh, clean water. Thoroughly wash feed and water bowls on a regular basis. It is always good practice to wash hands thoroughly after feeding and/or handling animals.
- This diet is not for human consumption.

Storage Conditions

For best results, reseal the bag between uses or store contents of open paper sack in container with sealing lid. Store in a cool (75°F/24°C or colder), dry (approximately 50% RH) location free from rodents and insects. Do not offer moldy or insect-infested feed to animals as it may result in illness, performance loss or death. Freezing will not harm the diet and may extend freshness. Use within 1 year of bag manufacturing or "Best if Used By" date.
