Ingredients

Ground Oats, Dehydrated Alfalfa Meal, Dehulled Soybean Meal, Oat Hulls, Ground Soybean Hulls, Dicalcium Phosphate, Brewers Dried Yeast, Ground Corn, Calcium Carbonate, Salt, Soybean Oil, DL-Methionine, Choline Chloride, Pyridoxine Hydrochloride, Vitamin E Supplement, Ferrous Sulfate, Cholecalciferol (Vitamin D3), Folic Acid, Vitamin A Acetate, Zinc Oxide, Manganous Oxide, Preserved with Mixed Tocopherols, Thiamine Mononitrate, Ferrous Carbonate, Nicotinic Acid (Niacin), Calcium Pantothenate, Citric Acid (a Preservative), Copper Sulfate, Menadione Sodium Bisulfite Complex (Vitamin K), Vitamin B12 Supplement, Riboflavin-5-Phosphate, Zinc Sulfate, Calcium Iodate, Rosemary Extract, Cobalt Carbonate, Sodium Selenite, Biotin.

Feeding Directions

- Feed ad libitum to birds such as ostriches, emus, rheas, and cassowaries.
- Feed to adult animals during the off-breeding season or to adult birds not kept for breeding purposes.
 - Amount of feed consumed will depend upon age of animal and time of year.
- Always provide plenty of fresh, clean water.
- Thoroughly wash feed and water bowls on a regular basis. It is always good practice to wash hands thoroughly after feeding and/or handling animals.
- This diet is not for human consumption.

Storage Conditions

For best results, reseal the bag between uses or store contents of open paper sack in container with sealing lid. Store in a cool (75°F/24°C or colder), dry (approximately 50% RH) location free from rodents and insects. Do not offer moldy or insect-infested feed to animals as it may result in illness, performance loss or death. Freezing will not harm the diet and may extend freshness. Use within 1 year of bag manufacturing or "Best if Used By" date.
